What is Title I?

Title I is most often described as an in house intervention program run by highly qualified teachers and sometimes assisted by classroom paraprofessionals. These paraprofessionals are also highly qualified and can provide to any student that needs literacy and math support. It is a program that is federally funded and contains guidelines to assure that students who demonstrate a need are assisted to promote their success.

Does my child receive Title I services?

Since Hillman Elementary is considered to be a School Wide Title I school, all students are eligible to receive assistance. Students are referred to Title I services based on their test scores in literacy and mathematics.

Therefore, if a student demonstrates the need for extra assistance and is not being serviced by Special Education, then he or she may be referred to Title I.
