Virtual

- Students in grades K-12 attend school in-person all day, every day.
- No Mask are required.
- Report Cards are issued as per HCS Calendar of Events.

- Students will follow a set schedule of both synchronized and asynchronous learning with their classroom teacher.
- The schedule will reflect that of the traditional school day.
- Attendance is required, recorded, and monitored.
- Students work is assessed in a timely manner and constructive qualitative and quantitative feedback is given by the teacher.
- Report Cards are issued per HCS Calendar of Events.

- Students attend virtual classes as scheduled.
- Commit to staying enrolled in this option for a minimum of one semester.
- Requires significant and consistent support from parents/guardians.
- Instruction is provided asynchronously.
- This service may be provided through a third-party vendor or with HCS teacher(s).
- This option means that your child may not have the traditional HCS teacher or curriculum.
- Must be approved by parent/guardian and Administration.
- Report Cards may not follow the traditional calendar.
