



## Dual Enrollment Agreement: Waive PostSecondary Course Agreement



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### The Agreement

The agreement provides for acceleration of Hillman Community Schools high school students through the dual enrollment program through Alpena Community College and provides for identification of eligible students through placement testing, and student advisement. Dual enrollment courses are offered as part of the regular college course sections on the college campus, online, and in special sections when appropriate and as identified for Hillman Community Schools.

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### Dual Enrollment Description

- The purpose of dual enrollment is to allow acceleration of academically-talented students while still enrolled in high school to take courses at the College which count toward high school credit and toward a college credit.
- Dual enrollment credits may be in addition to the normal high school load or a part of the student's regular load.
- The normal process of course selection includes communication between the enrollment/advisement service of Alpena Community College and the staff at Hillman Community Schools.

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### Post-Secondary Course Limits

Hillman Community Schools and Alpena Community College agree to waive the postsecondary course limit for the student listed below and to enroll in more that 10 postsecondary courses during their career at Hillman Community Schools.
